




<p><a href="#">WIC</a></p> 	<p>Pregnant moms, families/ caregivers with infants, children age 5 and under who meet eligibility requirements.</p> <p>Breastfeeding and nutrition support, community referrals supplemental foods and infant formula.</p>	Yes	Yes	Virtual visits available	Grocery stores
<p><a href="#">SNAP</a></p> 	<p>Families, seniors, individuals who meet eligibility guidelines.</p> <p>EBT dollars for groceries and eligible prepared foods.</p>	Yes	Yes	Virtual visits/online application available	Grocery stores, Approved farmers markets and vendors
<p><a href="#">P-EBT</a></p> 	<p>Special EBT benefit for families who received free/reduced family meals prior to pandemic. Benefit dollars added to existing SNAP families or special P-EBT card sent to free/reduced school meal families through mail. Eligible families who have not received card can input information in P-EBT portal through Aug 1.</p>	Qualified if on school meals	No, but portal if needed to check eligibility	No, mailed or added to SNAP benefit	Grocery stores and farmers markets
<p><a href="#">Double Up Food Bucks</a></p> 	<p>Current SNAP participants</p> <p>Match SNAP and P-EBT dollars used at farmers markets, and participating grocery stores and corner stores. No limit, matched dollar for dollar. Double Up Match dollars are allowed for fresh fruits and vegetables.</p>	SNAP and P-EBT card required	No	No	Approved farmers markets and grocery/ corner stores
<p><a href="#">Summer Food Service</a></p> 	<p>Anyone under age of 18 years old. Free meals and snacks offered at participating sites</p> <p>Text FOOD to 877-877</p>	No	No	No	Yes - Participating Locations

<a href="#">National School Lunch Program (School Breakfast, and After-School Snack Programs)</a>	Free or low-cost school lunch meals, and breakfast and snack programs available at school sites  Check district/school site for participating information. <a href="#">CACFP</a>	Nutritious meals provided through participating adult and child-care, after-school care, Head Start and preschool sites. Site reimbursed for cost of meal.  List of participating sites available <a href="#">here</a> .	Varies	Varies	No	At Childcare Site
<a href="#">Food Bank/ Pantry</a>	Food banks and pantries available throughout state. Information on nearest food bank found through AZ Food Bank Network.	Varies	Varies	Varies	Yes (Though some local pantries/ food banks may offer delivery or mobile sites)
<a href="#">WIC and Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP)</a> 	\$30 dollar benefit offered to WIC families (\$30 per family) or seniors participating in CSFP program.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>WIC clients must show: WIC EzAPP and WIC EBT Card</li> <li>Seniors must show: proof of CSFP enrollment</li> </ul>	No	No	Yes, participating Farmers Markets
<a href="#">Produce on Wheels/ Market on the Move</a> 	Produce on Wheels and Market on the Move provide 60-70lbs of fresh produce for a \$10-\$12 donation.
